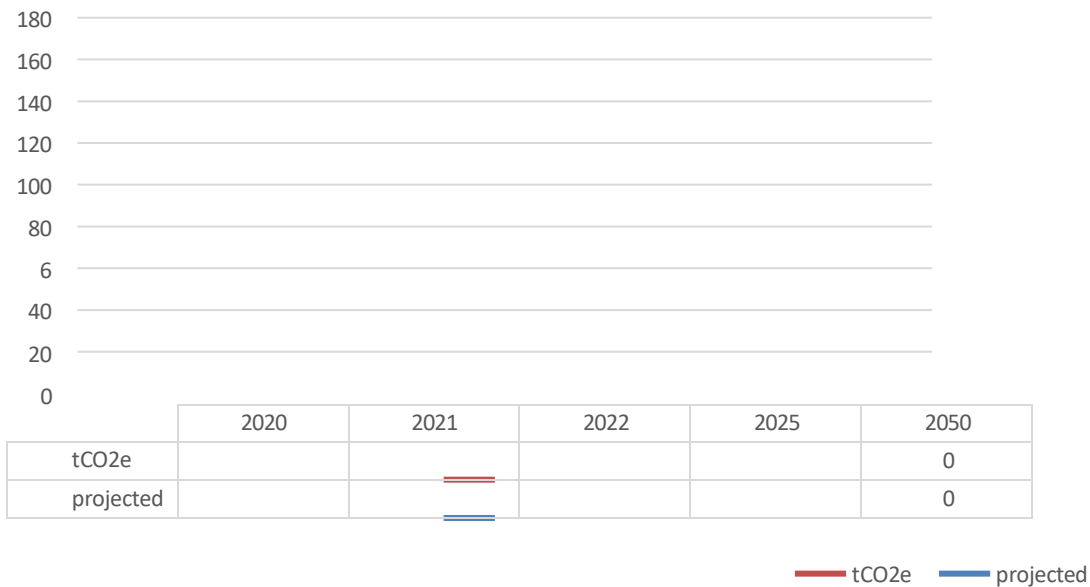

To continue our progress towards achieving Net Zero, we have adopted the following carbon reduction targets.

Completed carbon reduction initiatives

The following environmental management measures and projects have been completed or implemented

The completed projects ongoing are:

1. Replaced 8 x company cars with hybrid and fully electric vehicles
 2. Installation of Pod charging points x4 for visitor and staff use
 3. LED lighting replacement in all buildings
 4. Boiler replacement to ensure efficient heating
 5. Office days and Office based Staff allowed to home-working contracts to minimise commuter distance
 6. We hold all meetings virtually using facilities such as Zoom, Skype and conference calls
 7. Using a local supply chain where possible
 8. Eliminating single-use plastics across our activities where possible
 9. Recycling all office waste. Currently, 60% of our materials used are recyclable
 10. Procuring sustainable materials across our wider business operations. For example, we now recycle 100% of cardboard packaging from deliveries to be used as a free and environmentally friendly packing material.
 11. Printing and paper waste is has been reduced through use of digital and cloud based computing . All of our data is now stored in secured cloud based systems , (sharepoint, Clear care , Parim, Pcloud)
1. Fleet replacement programme to include increasing our % of electric and hybrid vehicles over the next 5 years
 2. Future plans to investigate improved insulation, solar heating and changing use and layouts of building to minimise heat loss
 3. Organising annual sustainability events in a webinar format. We commit to ensuring sustainability events/actions are communicated on a local and Barry Bennett-wide level within the organisation. This will include quarterly updates through email bulletins/team meetings

The carbon emission reduction achieved by these schemes will equate to a 25% reduction against the 2019/20 baseline.
